AIR QUALITY

Shawville and Luskville facilities

In the summer, the facilities have air conditioning in the kitchen and all playrooms (except the baby room for the Luskville facility, this room being small and having a door connecting to the next room). As soon as they open in the morning, all windows are opened. Depending on the temperature of the day, the air conditionings are activated a little before the start of the outdoor play period before dinner, or earlier in the event of extreme heat, and they remain functional for the rest of the day. The standard to ensure the health of young children in daycare, in this regard, is to keep a maximum difference of eight degrees from the outside temperature.

In the winter, one window per room is opened for a short period of time during the outdoor play period to make a change of air.

Luskville facility

Given the use of the commercial dishwasher with a temperature much higher than the norm, the period after dinner (dishes), as well as during the nap (toys), there may be a little more moisture in the air for a short time.

During the in-between seasons, we use the main entrance (between the two doors) to dry the children's outdoor clothes. By force of circumstances, there may be days when some smells might be less pleasant than others. On those days we post at the door that we have dried clothes in the afternoon to keep you informed.
